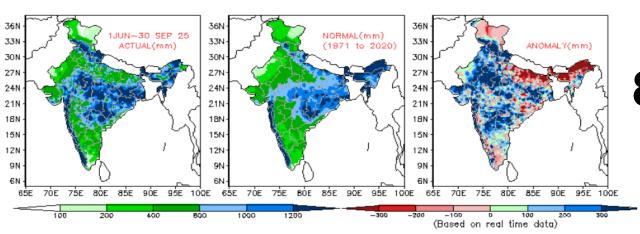

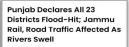

Cyclone Montha caused Rs 5,265 crore damage including Rs 829 crore crop loss in AP: Naidu



Vijayawada: Chief minister Chandrababu Naidu said Andhra Pradesh successfully minimized the impact of Cyclone Montha through real-time coordination, technological foresight, and meticulous pre-planning. Addressing a press conference after a high-level review on Thursday, Naidu credited proactive governance and inter-departmental synergy for reducing loss of life and property.

Naidu said the preliminary estimates pegged the total loss at Rs 5,265 crore. The roads and buildings department alone suffered damages worth Rs 2,079 crore, while the power and water

agriculture department recorded crop damage worth ₹829 crore. While no human casualties were reported, 120 cattle deaths occurred in separate incidents. "A comprehensive report is being prepared for submission to the Centre" Naidu said

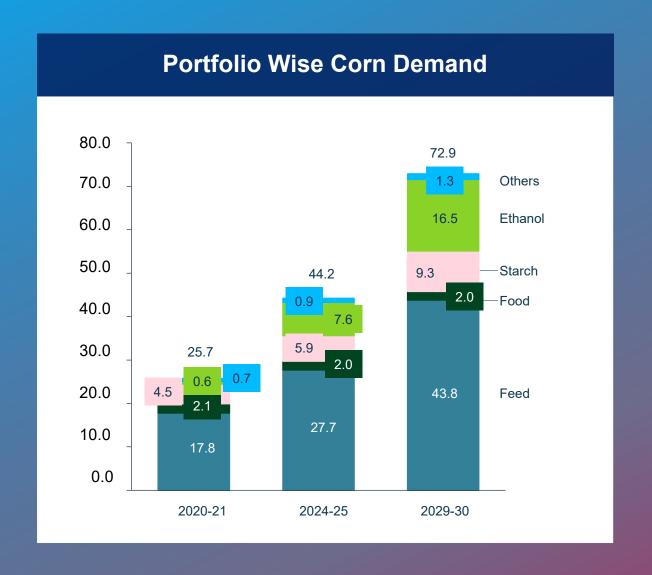
